The main contents will be adapted to the necessities of the students. During the course the progress of the student will be observed and the student will be assessed through individual assignments and the group and paired practices in class.

EVALUATION AND TESTING:

The evaluation will be a continuous process. In addition to the student's active participation in class, the instructor will assess the following points:

Practices in class, homework, participation and the interest in the class: 40%

Oral presentations: 40%

Final exam: 20%
