Note: In chart above, n/a signifies that a program of that duration is not currently available. The letter V indicates that requirements for a visa in that country vary according to the host institution selected by the student.

Argentina: Students will be required to bring supporting documents with them to Argentina, but will not formally apply for the student visa until they have arrived on-site.

Costa Rica: UCR semester students should be prepared to bring documents (including authenticated copies of the birth certificate and police records) with them to Costa Rica to solicit their student visa upon arrival. All visa processing will be done on-site in Costa Rica. SJDF students will not need a visa.

England: If students wish to work in England (for any length of time) or stay for a period exceeding six months, they will need a visa.

France: Students ALWAYS need a visa, regardless of program site or length of program. Additionally, programs longer than 90 days require the student to have registered with Campus France prior to soliciting the visa.

Hungary: All semester and year students will require a residence permit. Documents must be brought with the student to Hungary, but all processing will be completed on-site.

Ireland: Visas are not required, but an immigration card will be obtained on-site in Ireland. Students should be prepared to request documentation for the immigration card prior to departure. Further information will be made available post acceptance.

Italy: Students ALWAYS need a visa, regardless of the program site or length of the program.

Mexico: Student visa requirements vary according to the institution that a student will attend.

Poland: All semester and year students will require a visa.

Spain: Students will require a visa for any program longer than 90 days.
